A. CITIZENS CONCERNS - None

B. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – The minutes of the business meeting of May 24, 2006 were accepted by unanimous consent as presented.

C. HUNTER – FINAL MAJOR SUBDIVISION – After discussion amongst the Board and no public comment, a motion (Komelasky-Palestina) was passed by unanimous vote, approving the final minor subdivision plan for the Hunter subdivision, located on Almshouse Road, submitted by Van Cleef Engineering Associates, under the seal of David H. Artman, dated July 29, 2005, last revised December 1, 2005, contingent upon the recording of the improvement agreement and record plan.

1. Annual Surplus Vehicle and Equipment Sale – By unanimous vote, a motion (Long-Kinney) was passed authorizing the Township to dispose of surplus and equipment.

1. Proposed Resolution – Temporary No-Parking – By unanimous vote, a motion (Palestina-Long) was passed adopting Resolution R-06-14, a resolution establishing a temporary no-parking regulation on various streets within Northampton Township for the period from 12:00am to 11:59pm on July 4, 2006.


1. Accounts Payable – The accounts payable listing of June 14, 2006 was passed by unanimous consent.

G. GEORGE F. KOMELASKY

1. Dedication – Council Rock High School South – Land Development – By unanimous vote, a motion (Komelasky-Palestina) was passed adopting Resolution R-06-15, a resolution accepting the Deed of Dedication, dated April 6, 2006 from Council Rock School District for the dedication of the public improvements in the development known as Council Rock High School North.
2. Compliment – Street Cleaning – Mr. Komelasky complimented the Public Works Department for its recent street cleaning operations.
3. Detention Basin – Windmill Village West – Mr. Komelasky asked the Administration to investigate a complaint concerning a resident damaging trees in the detention basin of Windmill Village West.
