The regular business meeting of the Northampton Township Board of Supervisors was called to order at 8:00 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance to the flag was led by Mr. Komelasky.

- A. DISTINGUISHED CITIZEN AWARD – Chairman Komelasky presented the Distinguished Citizen Award to Dean Applegate, a seventh grade student attending Holland Middle School. Dean became aware through his grandmother serving in Iraq of sheet shortages in Iraq, collected over 200 sheet sets for donation to hospitals in Iraq.
- B. PLACEMENT OF AIR FORCE FLAG - An Air Force flag was placed in honor of Air Force Lieutenant Colonel Paulette Schank. The flag will be held until her return.

- D. APPROVAL OF MINUTES – The minutes of the business meeting of March 22, 2006 were accepted by unanimous consent as presented.

E. VILLA JOSEPH MARIE HIGH SCHOOL – REQUEST EXTENSION OF
CONDITIONAL USE – At the request of the applicant, this matter was continued to

the public business meeting of May 24, 2006.

F. JAMES E. KINNEY

1. Award Contract – Gasoline, diesel and Heating Fuel – By unanimous vote, a motion (Kinney-Palestina) was passed awarding the contract to Petroleum Traders Corporation at their bid price of \$1.6621 per gallon for unleaded gasoline (float cost per gallon) and \$1.9597 for low sulfur diesel fuel (float cost per gallon) and the contract for #2 heating fuel to Reit Fuel Oil Company, Inc. at their bid price of \$2.0390 (firm cost per gallon).
2. Award Contract – Maintenance Building – By unanimous vote, a motion (Kinney-Palestina) was passed awarding the contract for construction of a maintenance building to be located at the Recreation Center to Associated Paving Contractors for site construction in the amount of \$24,750.00; for building construction to C.B. Structures, Inc. in the amount of \$70,000.00; and for electrical construction to Verderame Electric in the amount of \$41,000.00.

G. PETER F. PALESTINA

1. Proposed Resolution – Parade/Assembly – By unanimous vote, a motion (Palestina-Kinney) was passed approving Resolution R-06-07 a resolution of the Township of Northampton, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, amending Chapter A145 Fees, establishing parade/public assembly permit fees.
2. Response to Citizen Concern – Lehmann – Mr. Palestina acknowledged a report submitted by David W. Connell, Township Engineer in response to a citizens concern from the previous meeting.
3. Police Officer – Mr. Palestina acknowledged the hire of a new police officer Elifa Soto.

H. VINCENT J. DEON


1. Accounts Payable – The accounts payable listing of April 5, 2006 was passed by unanimous consent.

I. GEORGE F. KOMELASKY

1. Planning Commission and Environmental Advisory Council Meeting – Mr. Komelasky advised the public that the Planning Commission and Environmental Advisory Council will hold a public workshop on Tuesday, May 2, 2006 regarding two proposed ordinances – riparian buffer and tree protection.
2. Reappointment – Planning Commission – By unanimous vote, a motion (Komelasky-Palestina) was passed reappointing Keith Garverich to another four year term on the Planning Commission, expiring April 30, 2010.
3. Appointment – Planning Commission – By unanimous vote, a motion (Komelasky-Kinney) was passed appointing Art Friedman to fill the unexpired term on the Planning Commission, effective immediately and expiring April 30, 2009.

There being no further business, Chairman Komelasky adjourned the meeting at 8:33 pm.
